#### **New Business:**

- 4. School plan update
  - a. Evidence of Character Strong is kids are using the language, support is being provided to teachers, and celebrating a trait each month as an assembly. At the core leadership level, members are brainstorming what are the big ideas for cafeteria, hallways, playground the essential things, what words do they want to use to guide how we set common expectations. Thus far, safe, respectful, motivated, problem solvers, and mindful are top words. Core leadership will draft the guide for each area which will evolve into the schoolwide posters.
