A Review Spectator Expectations

We truly appreciate the support of our spectators at CCS events! To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone, please review the following:

Supervision: Games and drama productions are not supervised events, so children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.

Food & Drink: No food or drink is permitted— water only in the gym and balcony, please.

Seating: All spectators for games, including children, must remain in the balcony for the duration of the event. For drama productions and concerts, there will also be seating on the gym floor. Running or playing in the balcony or halls is not allowed. Sometimes children who attend CCS believe they can be in the hall or other areas during games. This cannot occur. Parents, please ensure your children stay with you at all times.

Restricted Areas: The gym equipment room and other parts of the school are out of bounds. Spectators are to remain inside the school until the conclusion of the event. Thank you for helping us keep our events safe and enjoyable for everyone!


