LUNCHES AT CCS

We are pleased to share information about the Provincial School Lunch Program, launching in schools across New Brunswick on September 8, 2026, which we piloted at CCS in May and June last year. Through the program, families can purchase nutritious school lunches for their children at a reduced cost.

Program overview

- Your school's lunch provider is Ramada
- Lunches will be available all school days, starting the first day of school, with a regular and vegetarian option offered each day. Milk will be included with each meal.
- Families will pay \$4 per meal for kindergarten to Grade 8. The Provincial School Lunch Program will subsidize the remaining cost of each meal.

Online ordering

Please follow the registration and ordering instructions on the attachment in your email to create your account, register your child or children, and place lunch orders. (You will learn the name of your child's teacher to include in your ordering profile at the **Meet the Staff** event on Thursday evening.)

An updated copy of the ordering instructions is included in your email and will be available in print at the Meet the Staff event. These include:

- the link to your school's ordering platform;
- registration and ordering steps;
- ordering deadlines; and
- contact information if you need help.

Please register early and review the ordering deadlines to help ensure a smooth start to the program.
